- Monitor the costs of your projects.
- With your manager's help, follow-up financial guestions with the vendors if any.
- Create POs and control vendor's invoices monthly.

#### Tools:

- Maintain tool to track quality issues related to localized assets. Make recommendations for process and tool improvements based on this information.
- Research new localization tools (CAT, PSD scripts, plug-ins).
- Explore possibilities in terms of machine translation and neuronal translation.
